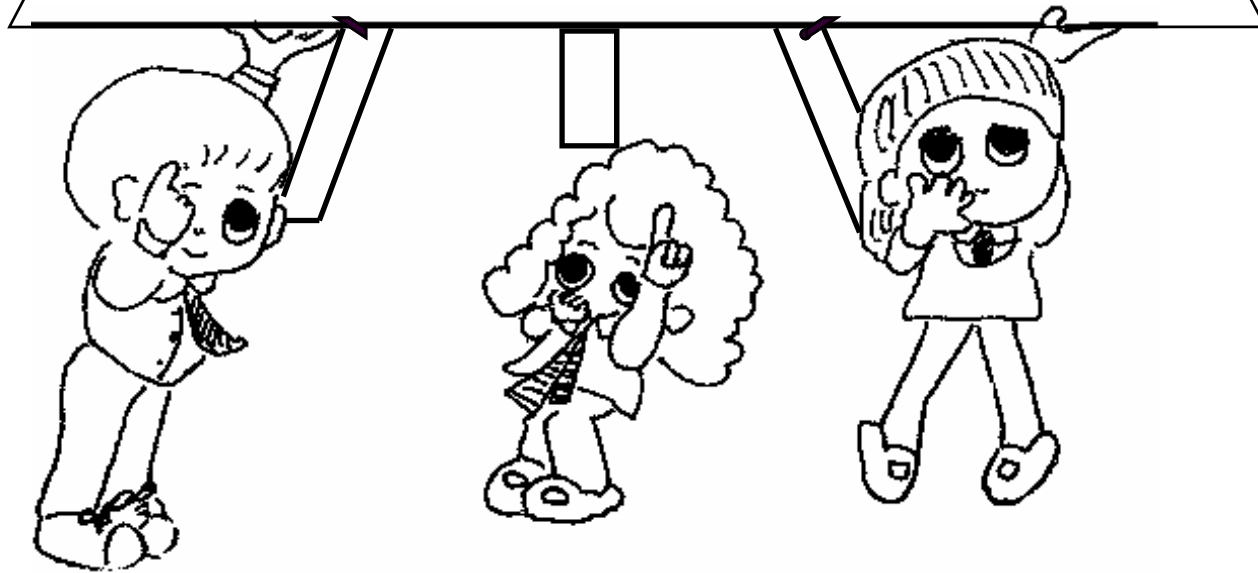

## Psalm 23



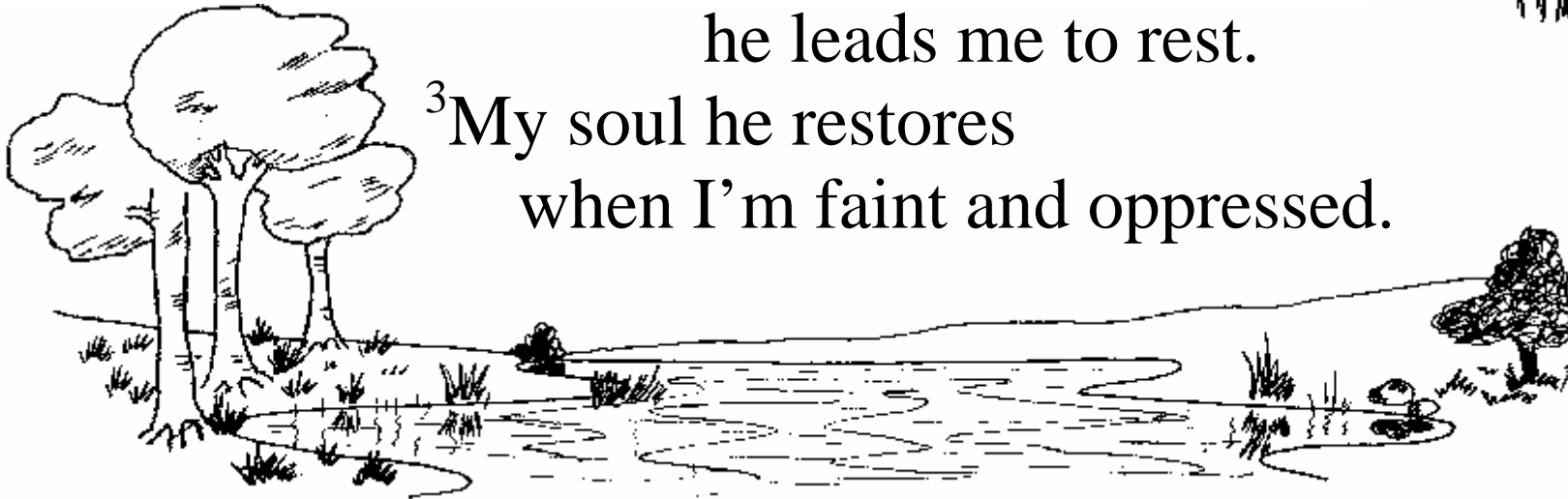
<sup>1</sup>The LORD is my shepherd;  
no want will I have.

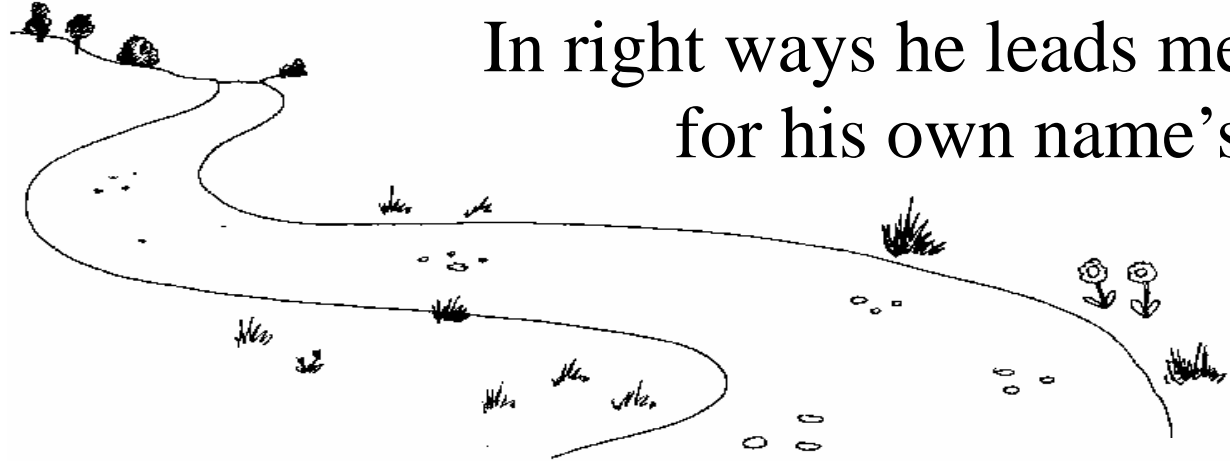
<sup>2</sup>Down in the green pastures he makes me to lie.



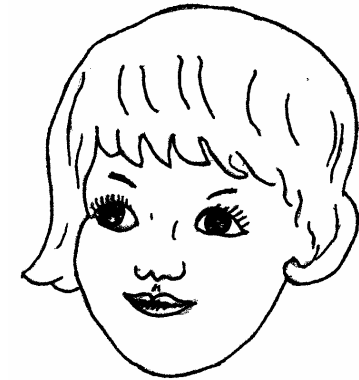
Beside the still waters

no evil I fear.

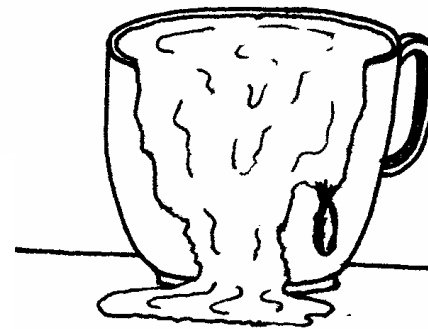
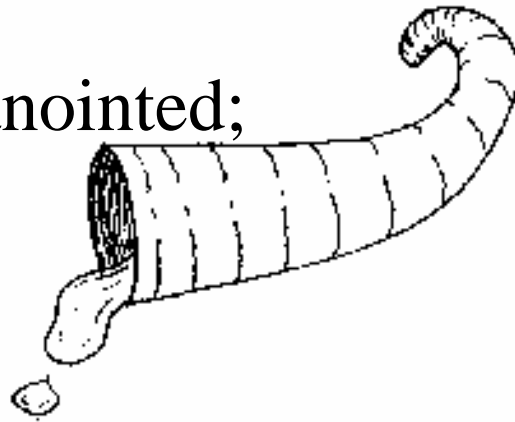
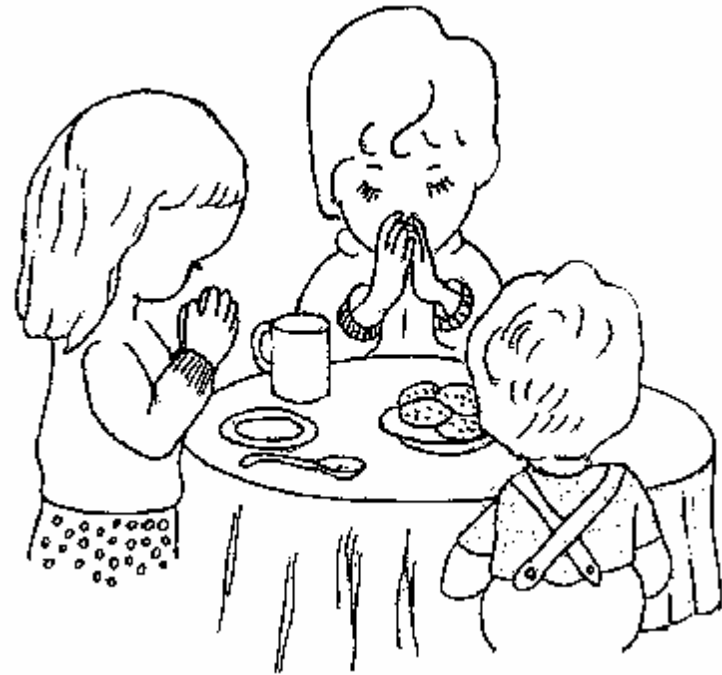


Your rod and your staff give me  
comfort and cheer.

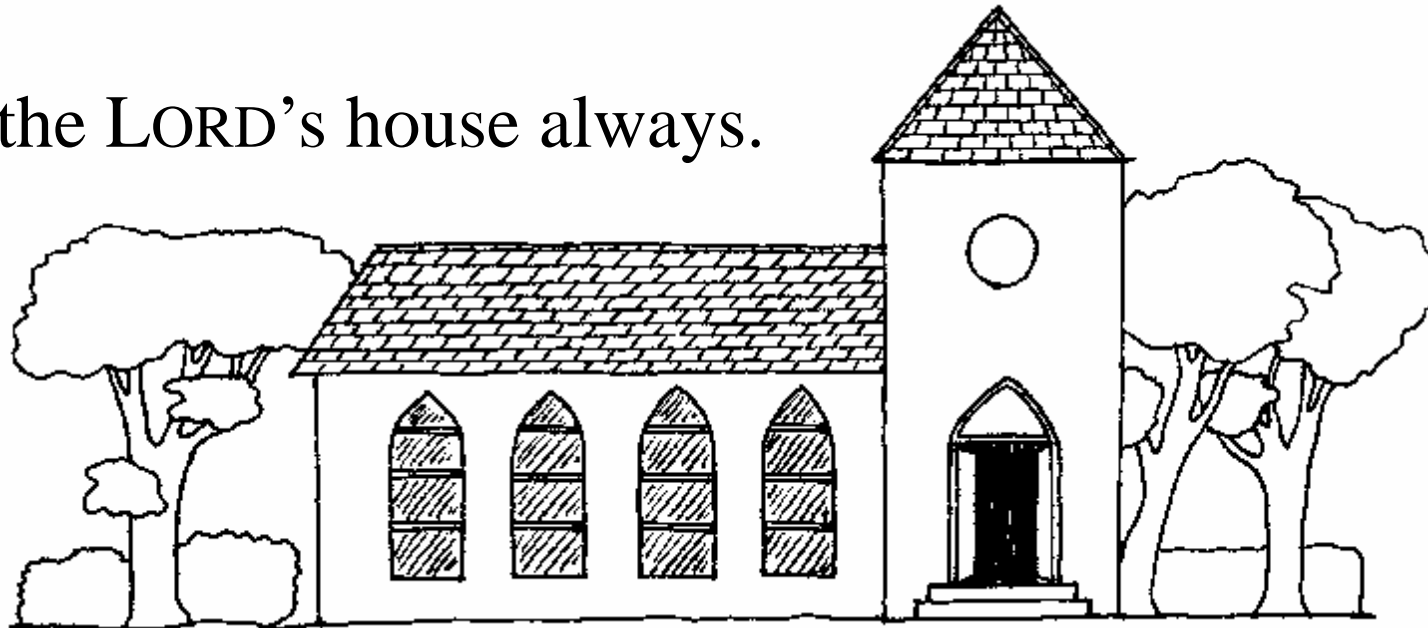
<sup>5</sup>You spread me a table

Shine on us with your face,

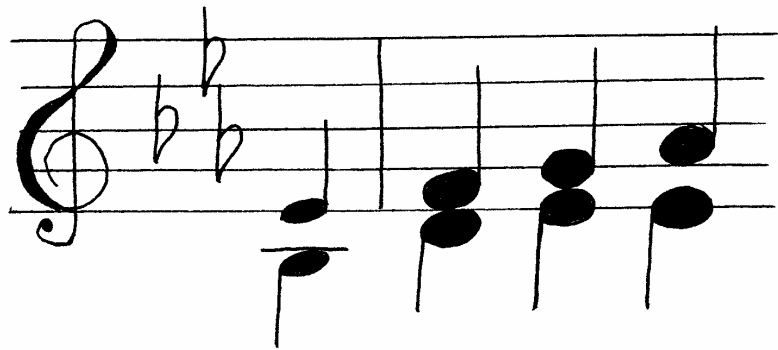
<sup>2</sup>That earth and nations all

Your way and saving grace.



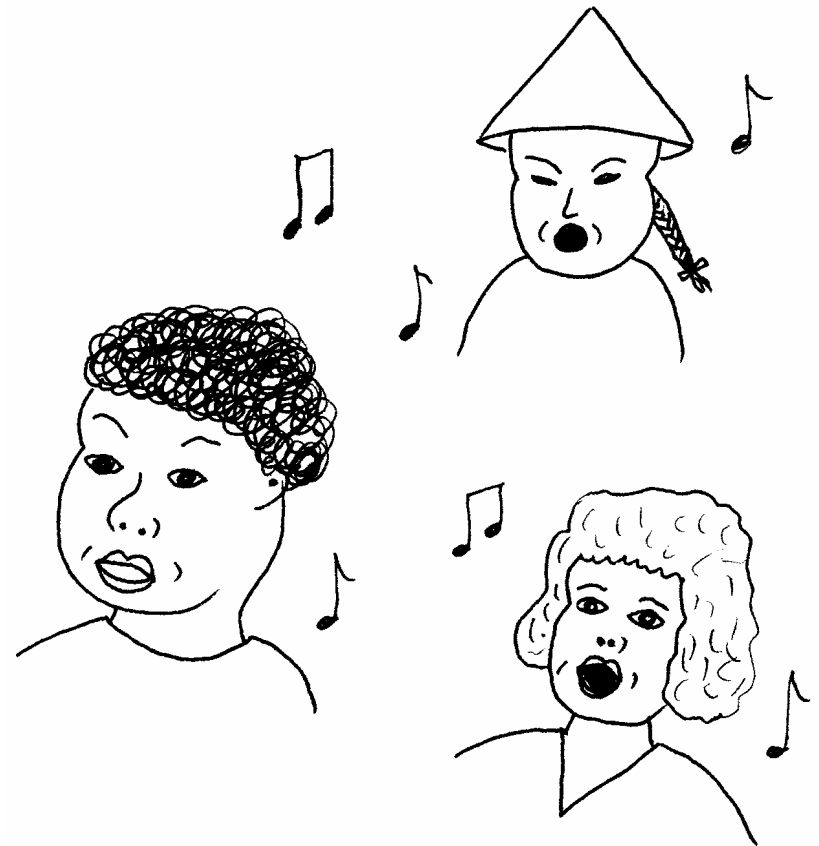
<sup>3</sup>Let people praise you, God;

In songs their voices raise.

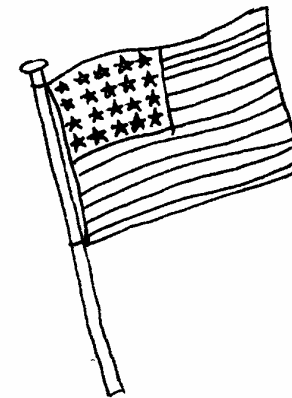
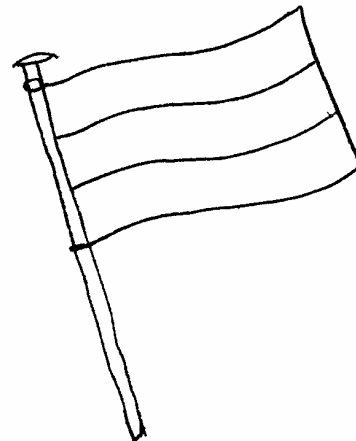
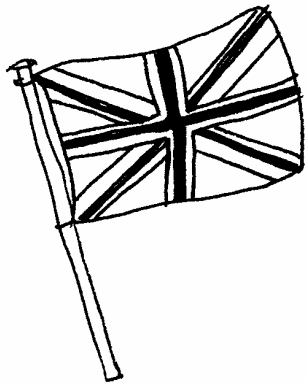
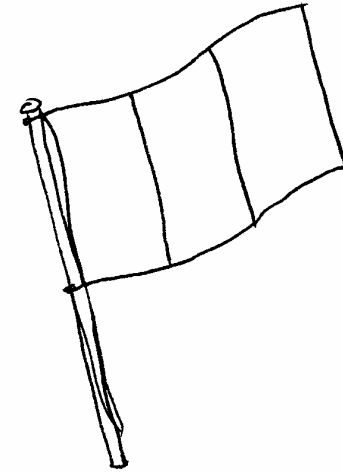


You'll justly peoples judge,

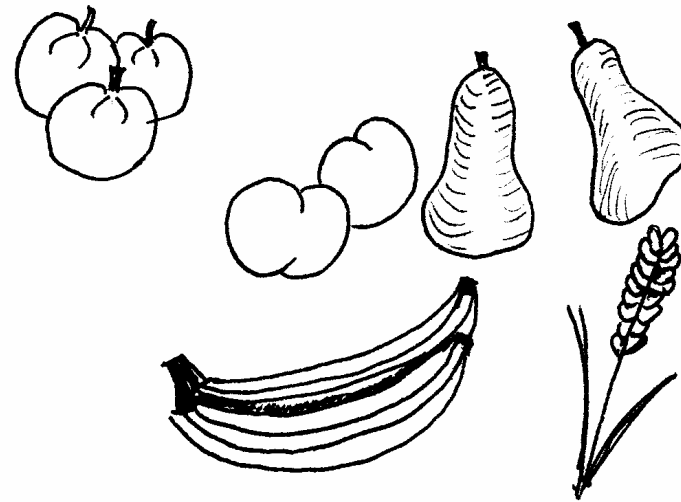
On earth guide nations all.
