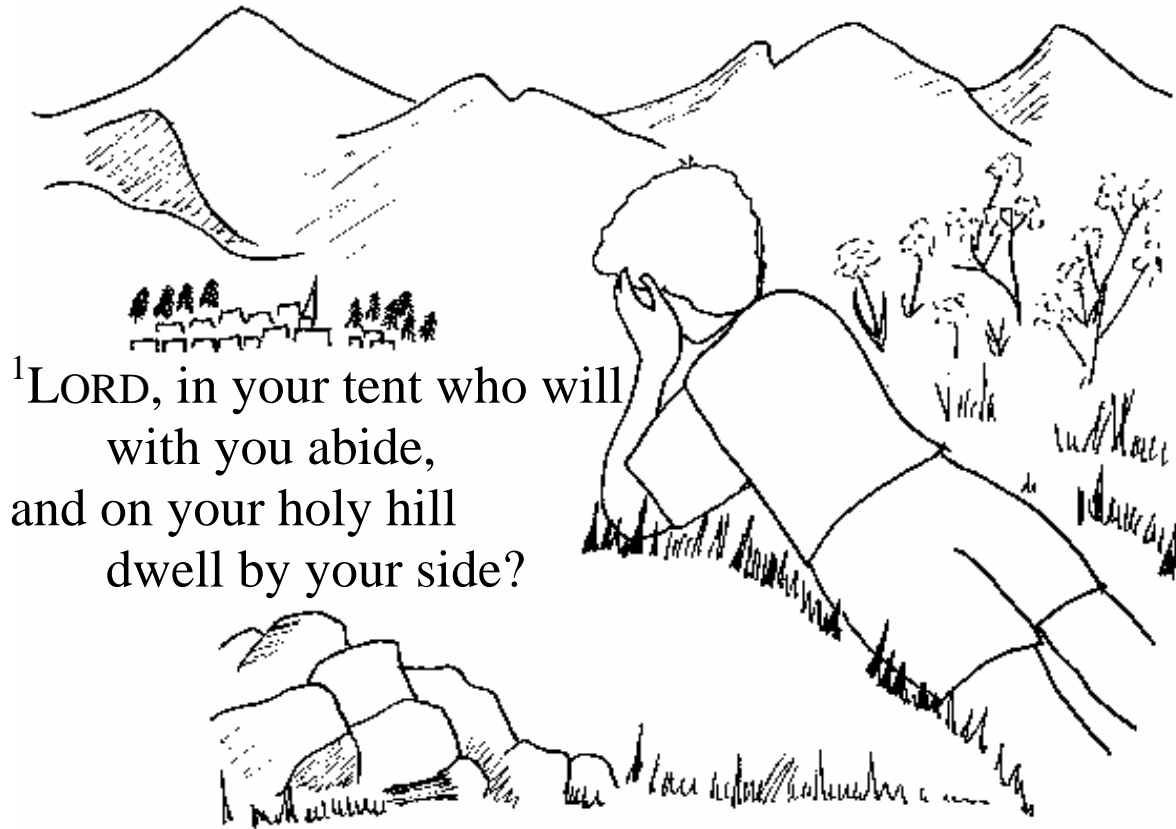

or harm his friend,

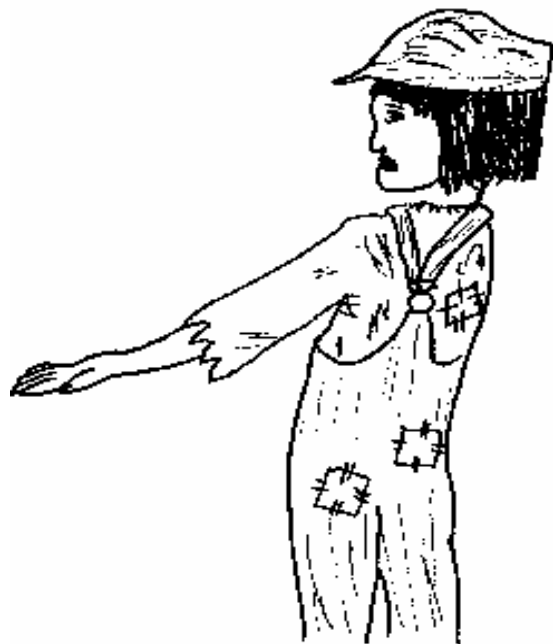
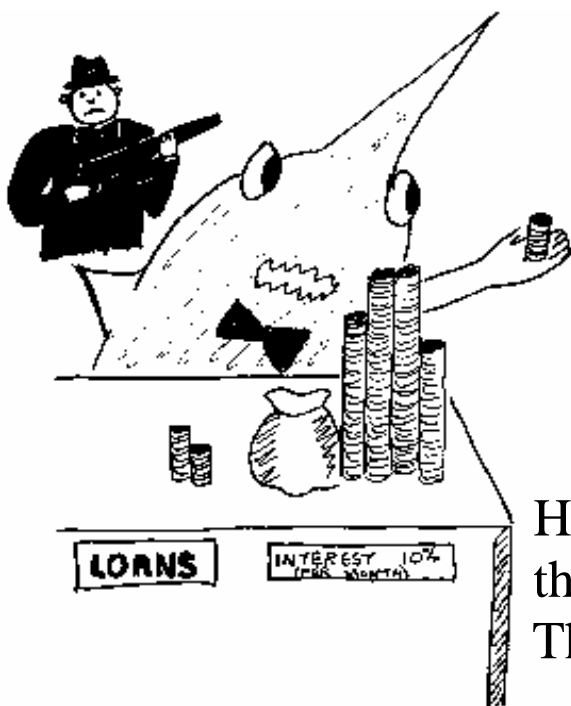
nor on his neighbour's name

his word he'll keep.

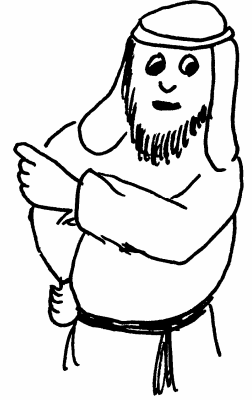
⁵His lending it incurs

had not been on our side,

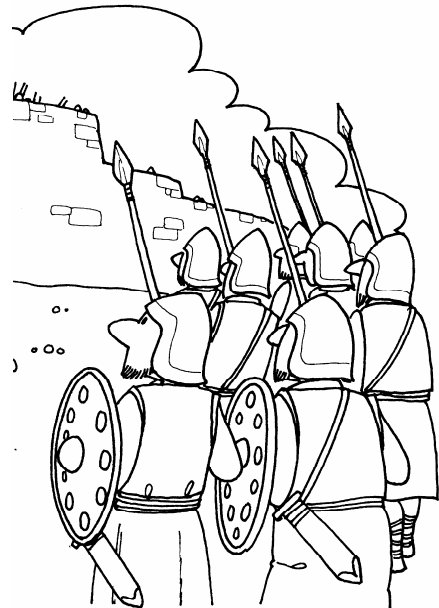


let those who are of Israel now say,

devoured us all alive.

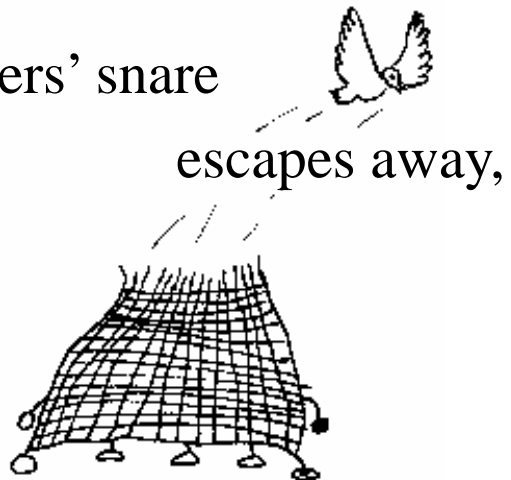
⁴Then the great waters would

His glorious  kingdom's


