

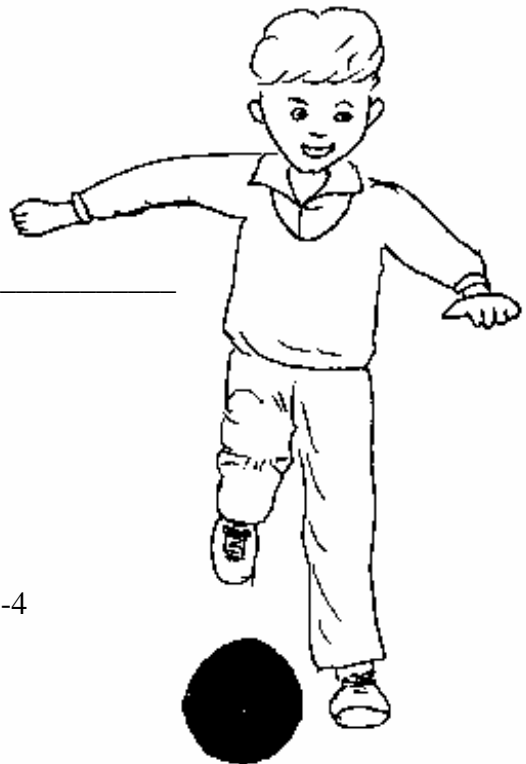

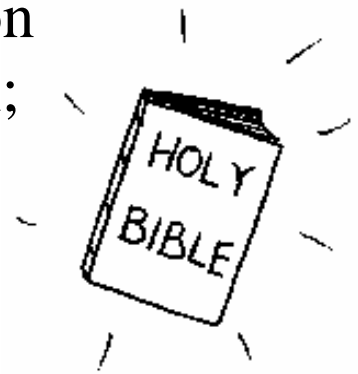
Psalm 98A

Shout before the LORD the king.

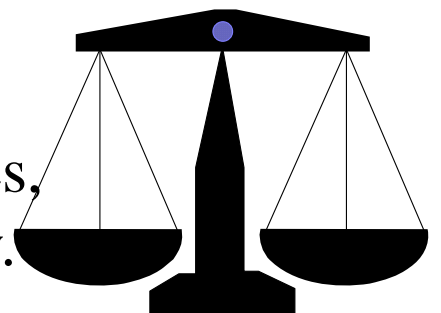


⁷Sea and all its fullness thunder;

With most perfect equity.

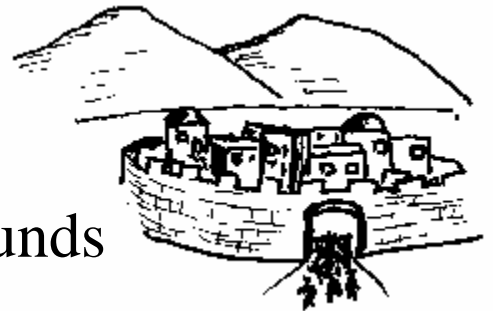


Psalm 125

Psalm 147A st. 1-4

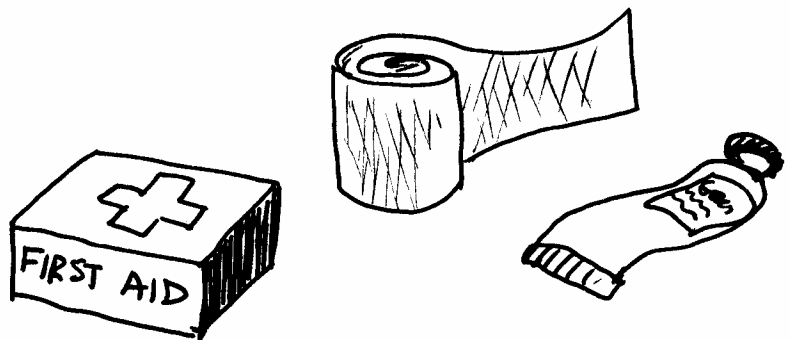


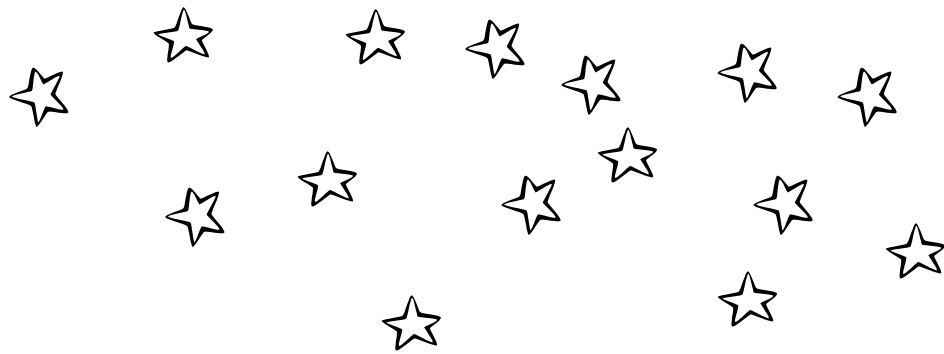
¹The LORD praise,
