

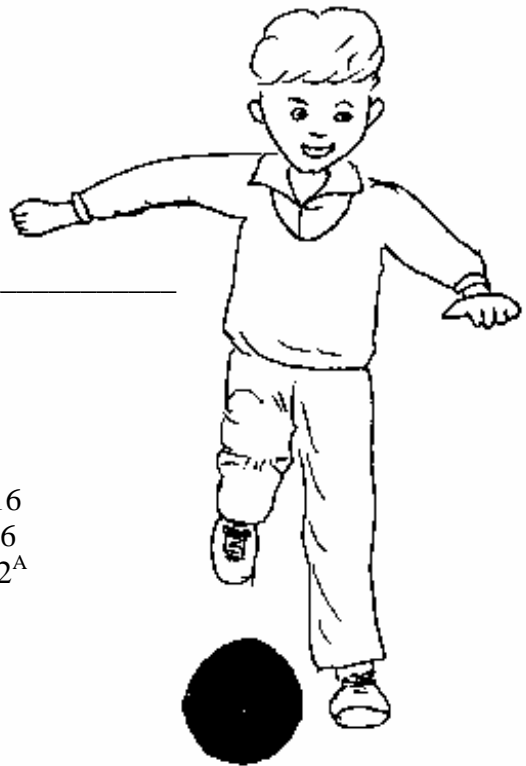

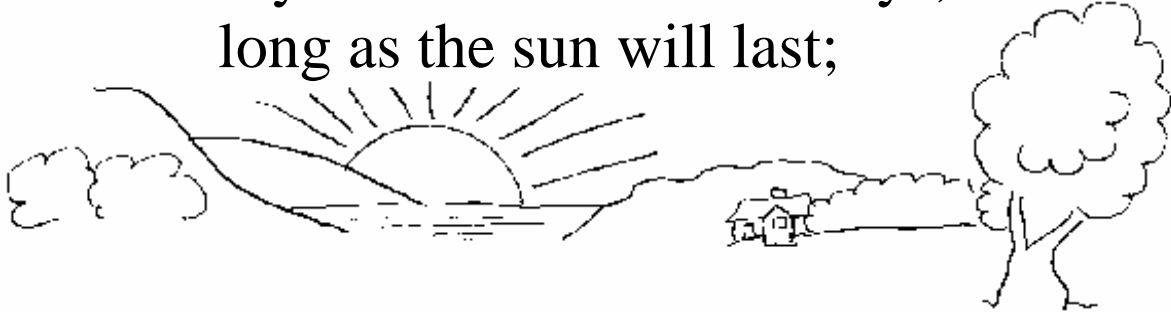

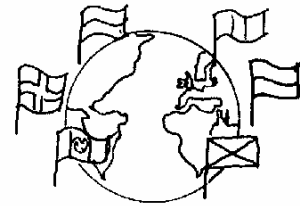

I grief and trouble found.

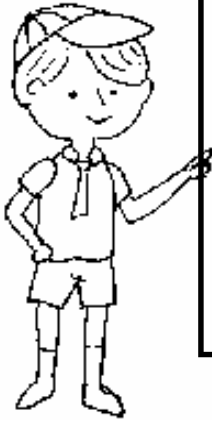


<sup>3</sup> <sup>4</sup> Then on the LORD's name I did call,

I earnestly do pray.'

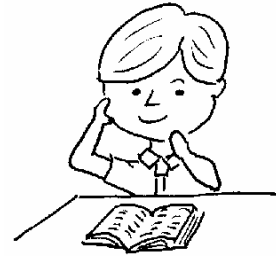

## Psalm 119 Part 2<sup>A</sup>



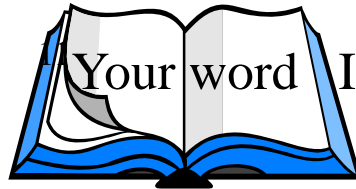
<sup>9</sup>How can a youth his life keep pure?

from your commands let me not stray.

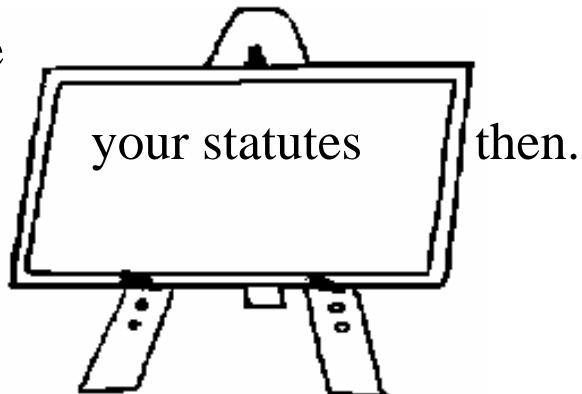

I with my lips have given voice,

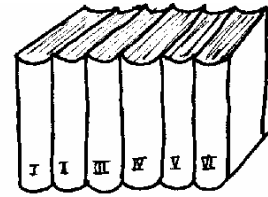

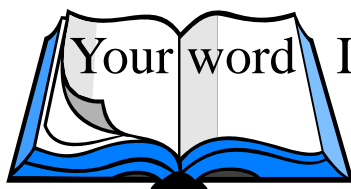

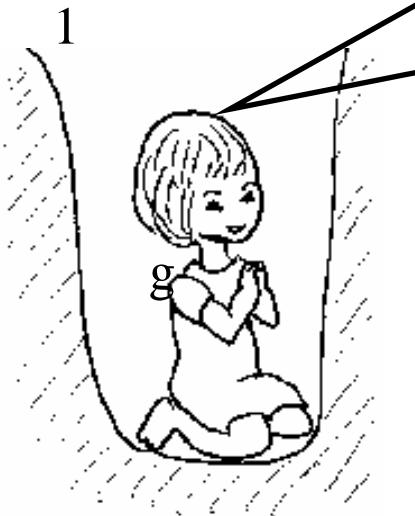

<sup>1</sup>LORD, from the depths I called you.

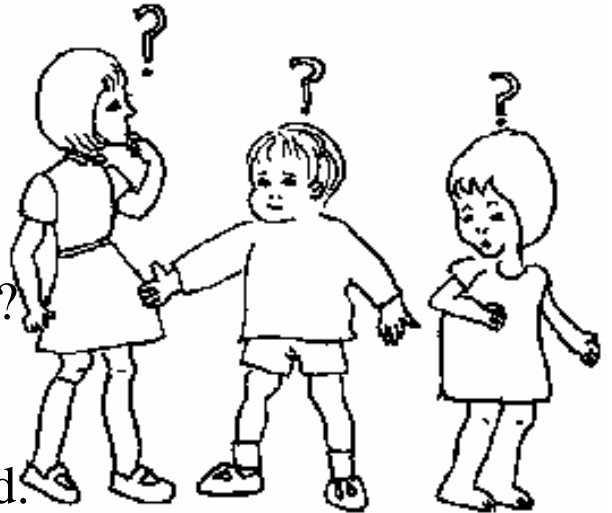
<sup>2</sup>O Lord, my voice do hear.

give an attentive ear.

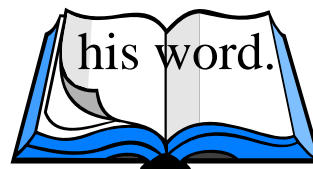
2 <sup>3</sup>LORD, who can stand

so that you may be feared.

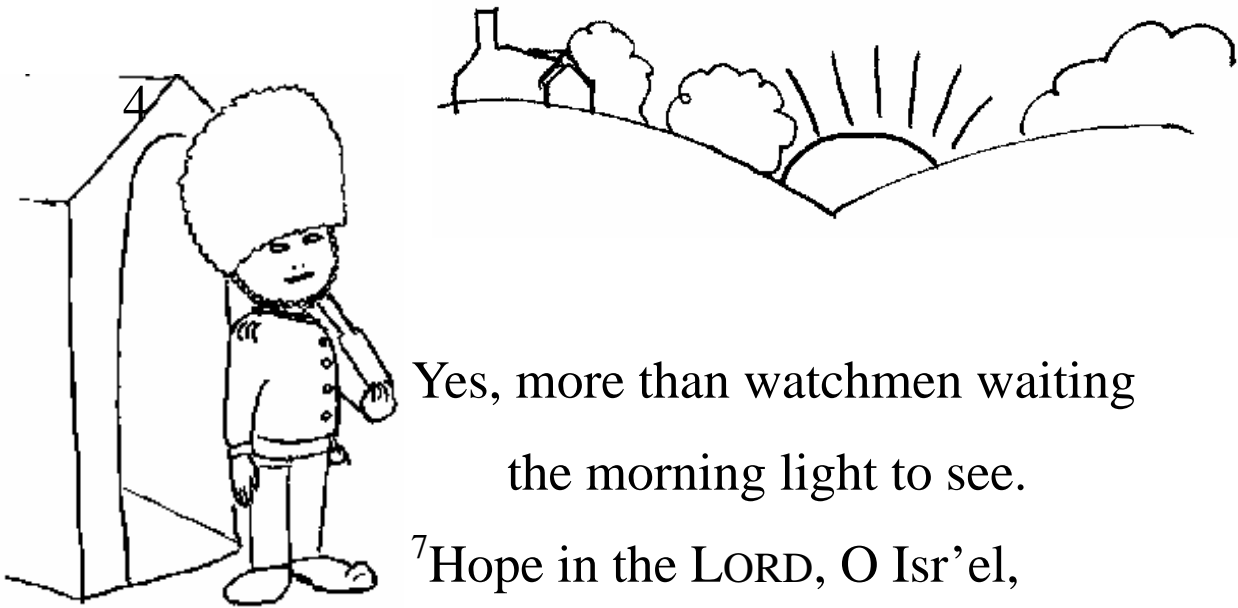


3 <sup>5</sup>I wait; I for the LORD wait.
