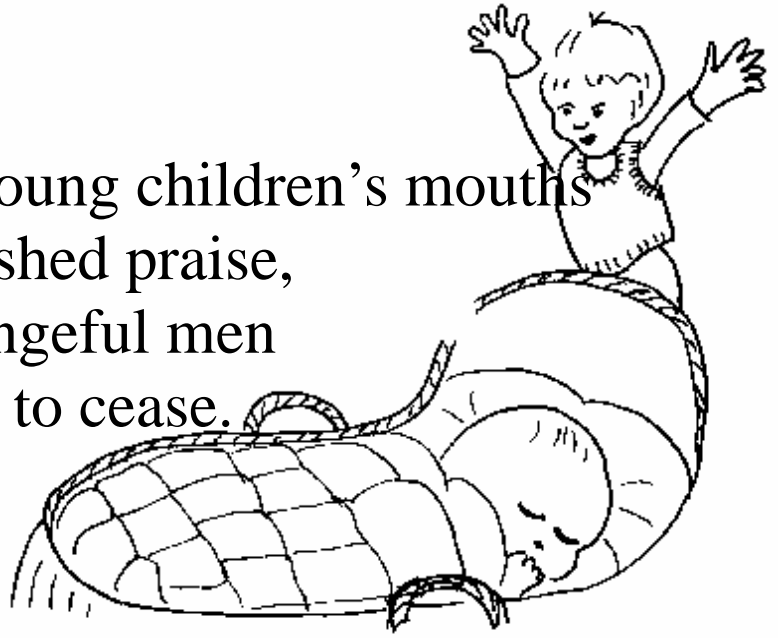

Psalm 8A

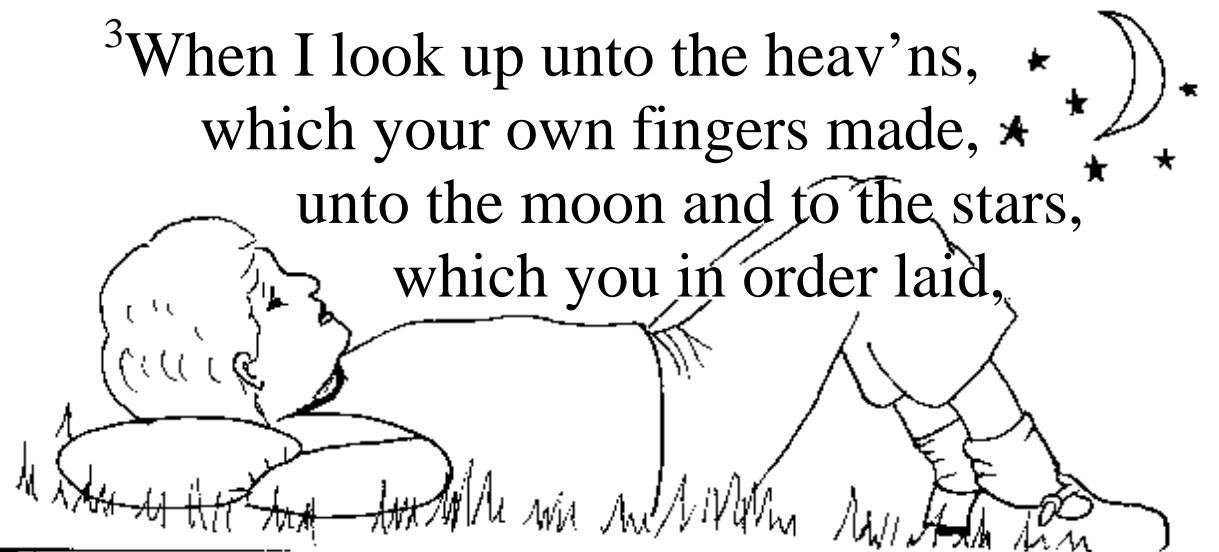


¹How excellent in all the earth,

above the heavenly frame.

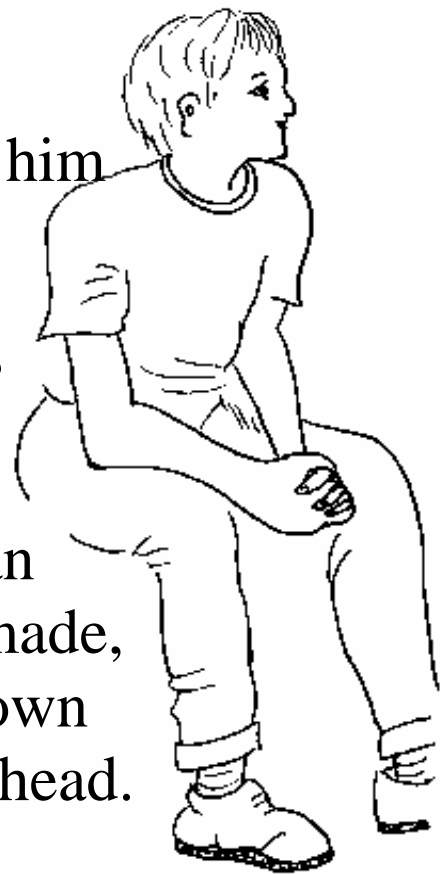
²From babies' and young children's mouths

the cattle and the sheep,





⁸Birds of the air,

to God my greatest joy.



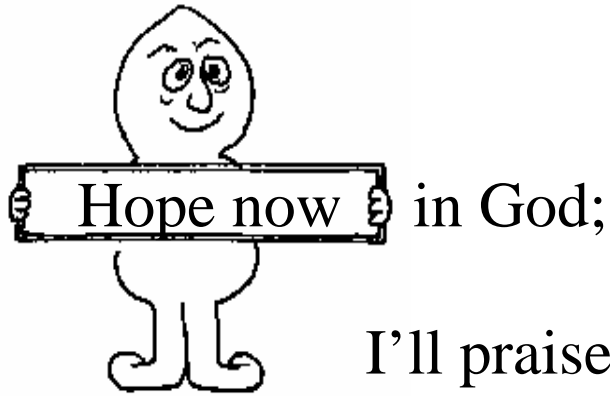

why so disturbed in me?

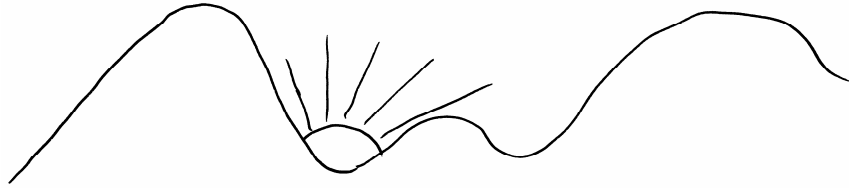

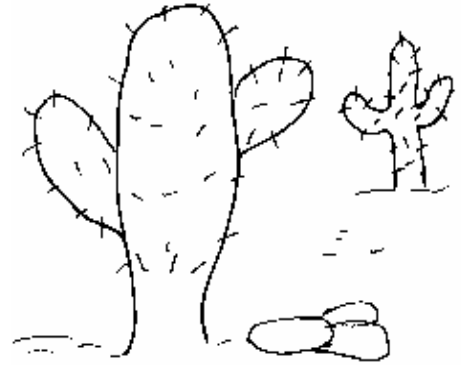
