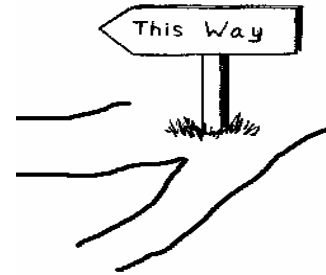
Psalm 25 v 3-8

let it

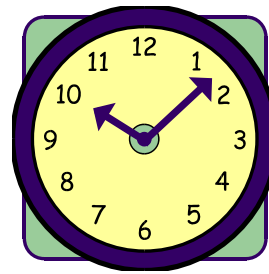


4 For you are God who sends

Psalm 34 v 5-8

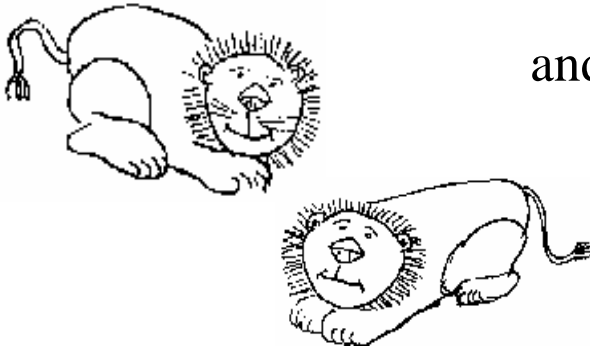


5 ⁸O taste and see the LORD is good;

will be with want distressed.

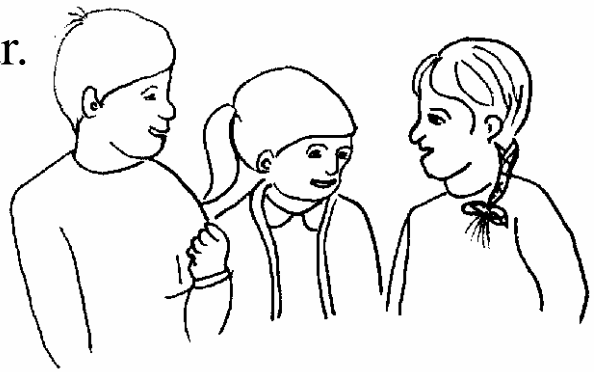


6 ¹⁰The lions young may hungry be,

your lips from speaking guile.

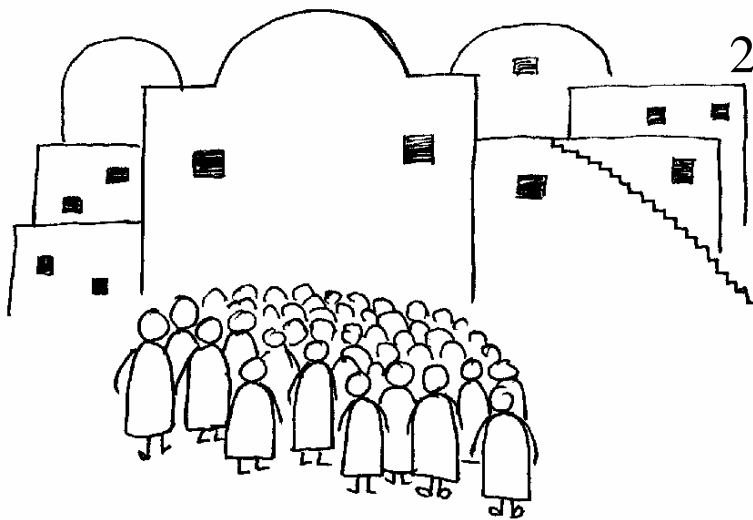
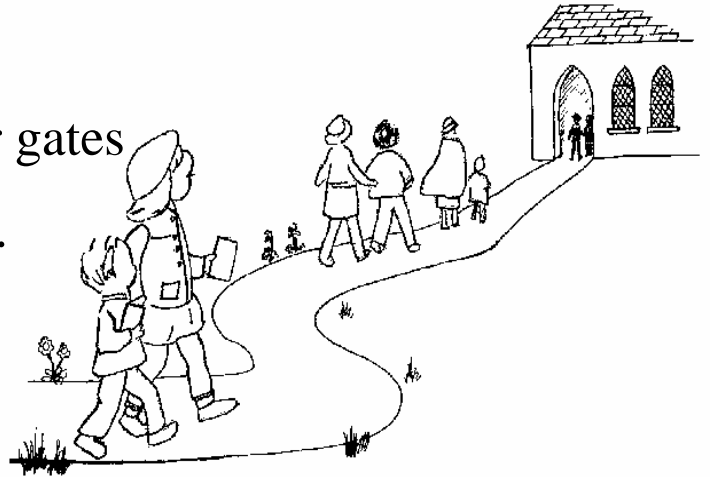


¹⁴Depart from evil, and do good;

our feet are standing so.



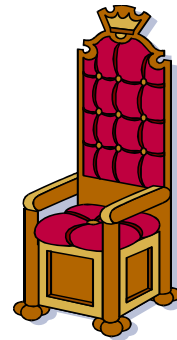
³Jerus’lem, as a city, is

as Israel had command;

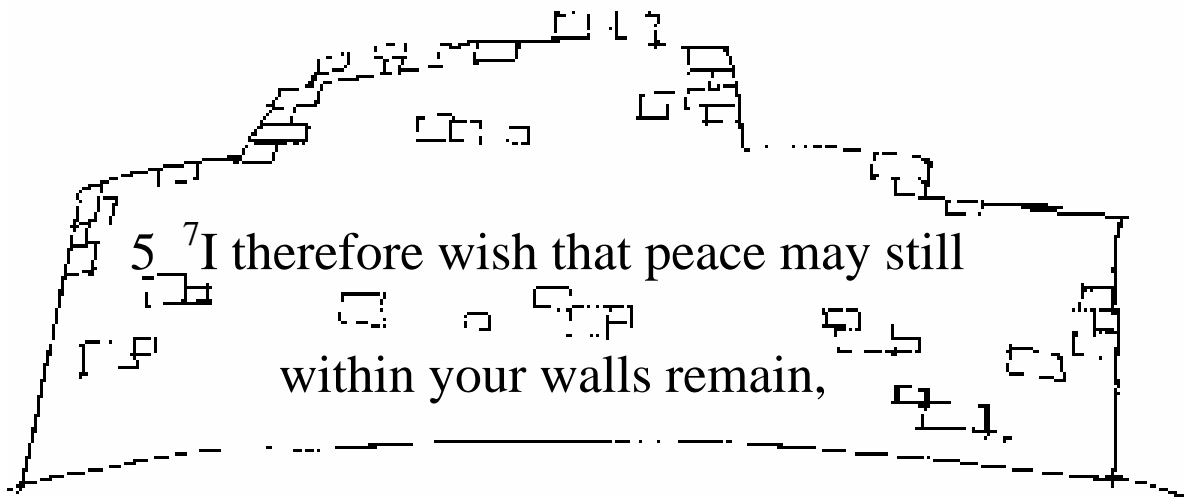
⁵For thrones of David's house are set;
