THE COVENANTER CHURCH: *ITS HISTORICAL ROOTS, SPIRITUAL RESILIENCE, PAST STRUGGLES AND PRESENT RELEVANCE*
The Reformed Presbyterian Church traces its origins to the Scottish Reformation. It survived intense and often bitter persecutions in the 17th century. Christ has maintained the witness of this denomination over the centuries as it has proclaimed the gospel and applied the Lordship of Christ to all of life. In four messages Prof Robert McCollum plans to tell the story of the church, showing that its witness is rooted in Scripture and that its testimony is exceptionally relevant for the turbulent times in which we live.
